

ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 2018**PARKING ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AND REGULATING PARKING****BOROUGH OF DICKSON CITY
LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

This Ordinance will amend and replace ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 2015, A PARKING ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON ENTERPRISE STREET AND PORTION OF EAGLE LANE in its entirety; and will read as follows:

An Ordinance regulating parking within the Borough of Dickson City, County of Lackawanna, Pennsylvania and establishing a schedule of fines for violations defined in the various classifications of said regulations.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the general health, welfare and safety of the public and the citizens of the Borough of Dickson City that parking be regulated within and along the limits of the below listed streets and parking areas; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the Borough of Dickson City to establish parking regulations and a schedule of fines for violations of those regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Code and the Vehicle Code vests in the Borough Council the authority to impose fines and penalties.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Council of the Borough of Dickson City establishes the following parking regulations and schedule of fees/fines(s) for violation (all fines are to be imposed on a per violation/per day basis).

Section 100. Parking Regulations Restrictions

No motor vehicle of any kind shall be permitted to park at any time in the Borough of Dickson City as follows:

- A. In any space, along either side of the cart way of the Borough road known as Enterprise Street from the intersection of Enterprise Street and Boulevard Avenue, being the westerly terminus of said Enterprise Street to its easterly terminus at the intersection of Eagle Lane.
- B. In any space, along either side of the cart way of the Borough road known as Eagle Lane from the intersection of Eagle Lane and Enterprise Street being the southerly terminus of said eagle Lane to a point northward to the center of a railroad track now owned by Pennsylvania northeast railroad Authority (previously owned by Delaware and Hudson Railroad).
- C. In any space, along westerly side of the cart way of the Borough road known as Scott Road between the intersections of Scott Road and Walker Street and; Scott Road and Link Street.

Section 500. Severability


