AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE


Dickson City Borough - Amendment to Ordinance #3 of 7/14/81, Amendment to an Ordinance providing for the Health, Welfare and Safety of the residents of the Borough of Dickson City, Pennsylvania.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Dickson City, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same, as follows:

Ordinance #3 of 7/14/81, particularly with respect to Section D(1) be amended as follows: Section D - No Parking Restrictions, "The following streets and/or parts of streets shall be deemed a no parking, standing or stopping areas: Main Street from the intersection of Notch Avenue east to the intersection of West Lackawanna Avenue, the northerly side of the street shall be deemed no parking. The southerly side of Main Street shall be restricted in the following areas: 150 feet west of Bowman Street and 150 east of Bowman Street on Main Street, 150 feet west of Mary Street and 150 east of Mary Street on Main Street, 150 feet west of Pancoast Street and 150 feet east of Pancoast Street on Main Street, 300 feet west of Lackawanna Avenue on Main Street, an area commencing 198 feet from the corner of Main Street and Boulevard Avenue in a generally westerly direction, then for a distance of 21½ feet westerly on the southerly side of Main Street.


