

ORDINANCE

An Ordinance of the Borough of Dickson City, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania, establishing fire lanes at commercial buildings and places of public assembly, setting forth penalties for violations of said Ordinance.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Dickson City, and it is hereby ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I
ESTABLISHMENT OF FIRE LANES AT COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS
AND PLACES OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLY

There shall be maintained on private property held open or devoted to public use one or more fire lanes to provide unimpeded ingress and egress for fire department vehicles, equipment, and personnel of at least 12 feet in width. Said lanes shall be laid out by the property owners after consultation with the fire company, and shall be so located as to provide convenient access to the buildings and the fire hydrant servicing said buildings. The lanes shall be marked in any way as to provide reasonable notice to members of the public of the existence of said lanes.

SECTION II
VIOLATIONS

Any person or persons who shall obstruct or cause to be obstructed a fire lane shall be guilty of a violation of this Ordinance, and upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$15.00 and the cost of prosecution.

SECTION III
SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any

sentence, clause, or section of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, or sections of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV
EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
