Recycling/Refuse Collection Schedule

Recyclable Items: All recyclable items will be picked up on the same schedule as your regular garbage throughout the Borough. Recyclable items such as metal cans, glass jars and plastic bottles are to be rinsed with no lids and can be co-mingled. Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, phone books and cardboard are to be tied with string or placed in paper bags set on top of recyclable items in container. Put out the evening before along with your regular garbage. . <u>PLEASE DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS</u>

Cardboard: Corrugated cardboard will be picked up with your weekly garbage and recycling. Please flatten all boxes and bundle with string.

Demolition or Construction debris: will not be picked up. You may reserve the use of a Borough truck for a fee to dispose of this type of materials. (See below)

Spring Clean-up Items: TV's, tables, couches, chairs, bed frame, mattress, clothing, toys, paint cans (dried out, lid off) should be put out during Spring Cleanup. <u>Liquidation of estate items or cleaning out of homes or apartments is not considered Spring Cleanup.</u> You may reserve the Borough truck or you can obtain a dumpster on your own. (See below)

Truck Fees: For one hundred and twenty five dollars (\$125.00) you can use a Borough truck in which you will load, and the Borough will haul away. Currently for trees and brush the truck is available for twenty five dollars (\$25.00).

Ashes will be picked up on Mondays
